- Interact with adults and develop their presentation and communication skills by answering questions from visitors.

Students who are interested in participating in the Science Fair must complete the registration form and submit it to the office by **Monday 3 August**. Registrations are essential to ensure that appropriate safety requirements can be met, late entries cannot be accepted.

Please note: All entries and experiments must be safe and appropriate for a school environment. Fire, accelerants, toxic chemicals and explosives are prohibited.

This year, our Science Week theme is *"Seeds of Science – Nurturing knowledge for all."* Entries do not need to be limited to this theme. We encourage students to explore their own interests and showcase safe, creative and engaging science experiences and investigations.

We look forward to seeing our students' curiosity, creativity and love of science come to life at our Science Fair!
