

	Physical Education Students will: - refine and apply the fundamental movement skills in soccer. These will include passing, trapping, throwing and dribbling. - perform in a range of roles (captain, scorekeeper etc.) and positions (defender, midfielder, attacker, goalkeeper) to achieve successful outcomes in a team.
Technology	Digital Technology: Students will learn about common digital systems and the devices that connect to them, such as keyboards, cameras, printers and speakers. They will also practise safe and responsible online behaviours, including how to protect personal information and share digital content appropriately.
The Arts	Drama Students will discuss how they and others organise the elements of drama. They will use the dramatic elements of relationships, tension, time and place and narrative structure when improvising and performing devised drama including a shadow puppet play. Students will collaborate to plan, make and perform drama that communicates ideas. Music Students will manipulate elements of music to communicate ideas, perspectives and/or meaning when composing and practising for performance. They will collaborate to compose and perform to an audience of their peers.
Italian	Students will learn simple words and phrases to order food from the tuckshop and share their preferences. They will practise planning a shopping list, saying what they like and dislike, and using modelled language in speaking and writing activities. Students will also explore Italian sounds, patterns and cultural meanings, while comparing Italian and English.
