

Technology	Digital Technology: Students will complete two units this term. In the first unit, students will explore binary numbers by creating pixel-based images and learning how digital systems represent information. They will also investigate different types of data and how information can be stored and used in digital systems. In the second unit, students will develop their programming skills. They will follow, create and test algorithms that include branching, repetition and variables. Students will also create programs that allow users to make choices and follow different pathways.
The Arts	Drama Students will engage in learning about Commedia Dell'Arte and Ancient Greek Theatre. They will explain how drama from different cultures, times and places influences their own drama making. Students will work collaboratively as they use the elements of drama to shape character, voice and movement in improvisation, playbuilding and performances of devised and scripted drama for audiences. Music Students will explore ways that the elements of music are combined in music across cultures, times, places and/or other contexts. They will develop listening/aural skills and skills for manipulating elements of music to achieve expressive effects when composing, singing and playing instruments.
Italian	Students will plan and perform a Reader's Theatre for younger students. They will practise using Italian to share ideas, solve problems and speak with clear pronunciation, rhythm and expression. Students will also create short texts and explore connections between Italian language and culture.
